COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLD COAST
(MAKING OF LOCAL LAW) NOTICE (NO. 2) 2015

Title

1. This notice may be cited as *Council of the City of Gold Coast (Making of Local Law) Notice (No. 2) 2015*.

Commencement

2. This notice commences on the date it is published in the gazette.

Making of local law

3. Council of the City of Gold Coast (the "Council") has, by resolution dated 11 September 2015, made *Licensing (Amendment) Local Law (No. 1) 2015* (the "local law"). The local law contains anti-competitive provisions.

Existing local law amended

4. The local law amends *Local Law No. 16 (Licensing) 2008*.

Purpose and general effect

5. The purpose and general effect of the local law is to expand the scope of the local law to cover—
 - (a) publicising a matter on an advertising device through an amendment to the definition of 'advertise'; and
 - (b) advertising device structures (i.e. the building or erection of permanent advertising devices); and
 - (c) three (3) dimensional (3D) objects (i.e. sculptures and the like) used for the purposes of directly promoting a business; and
 - (d) holograms.

Adoption of consolidated version of local law

6. Council has by resolution dated 11 September 2015, adopted a consolidated version of *Local Law No. 16 (Licensing) 2008*.

LOGAN CITY COUNCIL
(MAKING OF LOCAL LAW)
NOTICE (NO. 4) 2015

Title

1. This notice may be cited as the *Logan City Council (Making of Local Law) Notice (No. 4) 2015*.

Commencement

2. This notice commences on the date that it is published in the Gazette.

Making of Local Law

3. Pursuant to the provisions of the *Local Government Act 2009*, the Logan City Council made *Amending Subordinate Local Law No. 1 (Subordinate Local Law No. 7.1 (Regulated Parking) 2003) 2015* by resolution on 15 September 2015.

The object of this local law is to amend *Subordinate Local Law No. 7.1 (Regulated Parking) 2003* to—

- (a) insert notes about local government regulation of off-street regulated parking areas;
- (b) delete a reference to vehicle registration labels;
- (c) amend the details of some off-street regulated parking areas;
- (d) insert the details of additional shopping centres where the local government will enforce parking areas for people with disabilities.

Consolidated Version of Subordinate Local Law

4. Council has, by resolution dated 15 September 2015, adopted a consolidated version of *Subordinate Local Law No. 7.1 (Regulated Parking) 2003*.

Inspection

 - (b) viewed on the website of the Department of Infrastructure, Local Government and Planning.
