The amendments apply citywide and to land in parts of Banyo, Belmont, Boondall, Bracken Ridge, Bridgman Downs, Brighton, Calamvale, Carina Heights, Carindale, Carseldine, Chapel Hill, Clayfield, Doolandella, Ellengrove, Enoggera, Everton Park, Fig Tree Pocket, Hawthorne, Heathwood, Hemmant, Kenmore, Manly West, McDowall, Milton, Mitchelton, Nudgee, Oxley, Pallara, Parkinson, Richlands, Rochedale, Seven Hills, Stones Corner, Stretton, Upper Kedron, Wacol, Wakerley and Yeronga and will commence on Friday 23 November 2018.

Purpose and General Effect

The amendments are intended to:

- correct typographical errors, mapping errors and remove redundant and out-dated terms;
- update and reflect the regulated requirements of the Planning Regulation 2017;
- update mapping to reflect current development approvals including Consent Orders of the Planning and Environment Court; and
