NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF MINOR AND ADMINISTRATIVE AMENDMENTS TO *BRISBANE CITY PLAN 2014* PURSUANT TO SECTION 3 OF PART 1 (ADMINISTRATIVE), SECTION 6 OF PART 2 (MINOR) OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE MINISTER'S GUIDELINES AND RULES MADE UNDER SECTION 20 OF THE *PLANNING ACT 2016* AND ADOPTION OF MINOR AND ADMINISTRATIVE AMENDMENTS TO PLANNING SCHEME POLICIES PURSUANT TO SECTION 5 OF PART 1 OF CHAPTER 3 OF THE MINISTER'S GUIDELINES AND RULES.

At its meeting on Tuesday 13 November 2018, Council adopted *minor and administrative amendments to Brisbane City Plan 2014* pursuant to Section 3 of Part 1 (administrative), Section 6 of Part 2 (minor) of Chapter 2 of the Minister's Guidelines and Rules and *minor and administrative amendments* to planning scheme policies pursuant to Section 5 of Part 1 of Chapter 3 of the Minister's Guidelines and Rules entitled Minor Package F. The amendments apply citywide and to land in parts of Banyo, Belmont, Boondall, Bracken Ridge, Bridgman Downs, Brighton, Calamvale, Carina Heights, Carindale, Carseldine, Chapel Hill, Clayfield, Doolandella, Ellengrove, Enoggera, Everton Park, Fig Tree Pocket, Hawthorne, Heathwood, Hemmant, Kenmore, Manly West, McDowall, Milton, Mitchelton, Nudgee, Oxley, Pallara, Parkinson, Richlands, Rochedale, Seven Hills, Stones Corner, Stretton, Upper Kedron, Wacol, Wakerley and Yeronga and will commence on **Friday 23 November 2018**.

Purpose and General Effect

The amendments are intended to:

- correct typographical errors, mapping errors and remove redundant and out-dated terms;
- update and reflect the regulated requirements of the *Planning Regulation 2017*;
- update mapping to reflect current development approvals including Consent Orders of the Planning and Environment Court; and
- update and reflect current Council policies and infrastructure design standards.
