Notice of a proposal to amend Brisbane City Plan 2014 pursuant to Section 18 of Part 4 of Chapter 2 of the Minister's Guidelines and Rules made under Section 20 of the Planning Act 2016, to include a major amendment (Heritage places and city views amendment) to identify and protect local heritage places, pre-1911 buildings, and key civic spaces and iconic vistas.

At its meeting on 31 July 2018 Brisbane City Council (Council) proposed to amend *Brisbane City Plan* 2014 to include the Heritage places and city views amendment (Major amendment package F).

Purpose and General Effect

The proposed amendments are intended to:

- Protect more of Brisbane's buildings constructed prior to 1911, by adding recently identified sites to the Pre-1911 building overlay map
- Maintain and enhance Brisbane's heritage by updating the Local heritage places incorporated into the Heritage overlay map
- Create a new Key civic space and iconic vista overlay code and map to articulate provisions for the
 protection of civic spaces and iconic vistas in Brisbane city.
