

Public notice of a proposal to amend the Transport, access, parking and servicing planning scheme policy that supports the *Brisbane City Plan 2014*, pursuant to Section 3 of Part 1 of Chapter 3 of the Minister's Guidelines and Rules, to increase car parking for suburban multiple dwellings to ensure that new multiple dwellings in suburban areas accommodate parking demand (Amendment package J).

At its meeting on 4 June 2019 Brisbane City Council (Council) proposed to amend the Transport, access, parking and servicing planning scheme policy that supports the *Brisbane City Plan 2014* to include increased car parking numbers for suburban multiple dwellings amendment (Amendment Package J).

Purpose and General Effect

The proposed amendments increase the amount of car parking required to ensure multiple dwellings in suburban areas provide sufficient on-site car parking spaces to accommodate parking demand.

Location details

The proposed amendment will apply to all of the Council's local government area.
