8. <u>BACKGROUND</u>

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W.A. Jolly Park (D0020, B-RE-1802), 50 Wesley Street, Lutwyche, is classified as a local general recreation park and local specialised community facility within Marchant Ward. The park features a playground, table tennis table, rebound wall, picnic area with shelter, water bubbler and tap and a site leased to the Community Supporting Police Inc.

Councillor Danita Parry, Councillor for Marchant Ward, has requested that the playground at W.A. Jolly Park be upgraded, as indicated in Attachment A.

Effective delivery of the project will require:

- removal of:
 - all play equipment, the shade structure, associated footings, concrete edging and softfall
 - removal of 2 seats and a concrete slab
 - removal of the bins, bin post and a concrete slab
 - design, supply and installation of a new playground for ages 2 to 12 years to include:
 - a new swing set (consisting of one infant, one senior and one all-abilities bird's nest swing), single rocker, spinner and a combination play unit with climbing options, a larger slide, monkey bars and/or a track ride
- supply and installation of:
 - a shade structure
 - concrete edging around the playground
 - rubber wear pads under the play items
 - softfall Takura bark
 - sandstone block seating under the fig tree and around the playground
 - a root barrier along the edge of the playground adjacent to the fig tree
 - 2 new seats and a concrete slab
 - a concrete slab for the bins
- reinstatement of the bin post and bins adjacent to the shelter.

Environment, Parks and Sustainability Committee approval is sought in line with the approved delegations for the Suburban Enhancement Fund.

It is recommended that approval be granted to expend \$275,000 from the Marchant Ward Suburban Enhancement Fund for the upgrade of the playground at W.A. Jolly Park, 50 Wesley Street, Lutwyche.

Funds are currently available in Program 6 – City Standards, Community Health and Safety.
