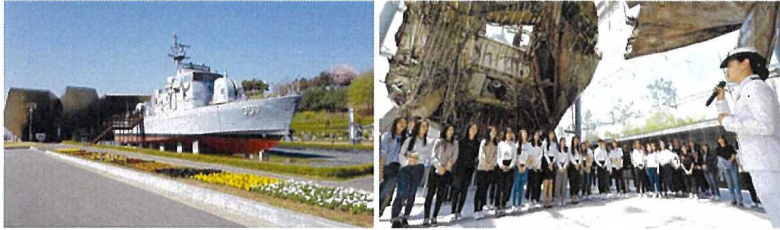

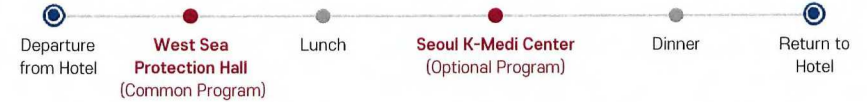
LG Innovation Gallery

Seoul K-Medi Center

The Seoul K-Medi Center is a comprehensive cultural space focused on traditional Korean medicine (Hanbang). It offers museum exhibitions, educational programs, herbal foot baths, and medicinal food experiences, allowing visitors to enjoy a variety of traditional wellness cultural experiences. Built as a beautiful hanok, it provides relaxation for both body and mind, and is located in Seoul's Yangnyeongsi, the country's largest traditional medicinal herb market. Yangnyeongsi has a rich history, dating back to the Joseon Dynasty (1392–1910), where it served as a charitable institution distributing medicine to the poor and needy. Today, the area continues to offer high-quality medicinal products and traditional Korean medical services.
